

SERVICE (MATING) CERTIFICATE

1. Should a breeder use a Boerboel male (or his semen) that does not belong to the him, this Service (Mating) Certificate must be completed.
2. Where frozen semen is used the veterinarian involved must sign and certify the document.
3. This Certificate must be given to the owner of the Boerboel female once the service/insemination has taken place.
4. The owner of the Boerboel bitch must forward this Service Certificate, together with the Birth Notifications of the litter to the Office (office@sabbs.org).
5. To prevent misunderstandings it is recommended that *Special Arrangements* (if any) be signed by both parties at the outset.
6. DNA profiles are required for all breeding dogs (male and female) for the registration of their offspring.
